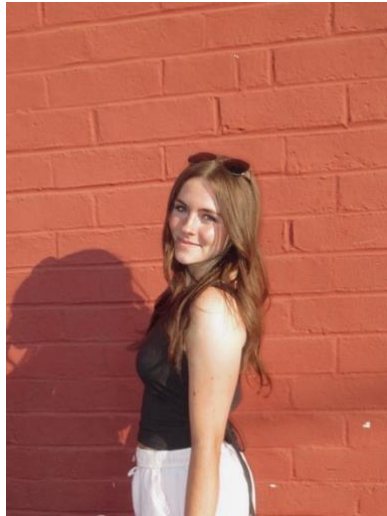


KYLEE BOSTROM
